Call to Order: Chairman Isbel called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Wandell led the pledge of allegiance.

Commissioner Anderson requested a moment of silence for Joseph Forgety.

Commissioner Wandell made a motion to approve the agenda seconded by Commissioner Yager. Motion passed by voice vote that included the attendance roll call.

Commissioner Mead made a motion to support the Mayor in calling for a workshop with the TN Valley Coalition for the Homeless and the Trinity Outreach Center of Hope to have a better understanding of their terms of outreach and assistance to see if Anderson County can partner with these organizations. Commissioner McKamey made a motion to authorize the Mayor to pursue a USDA Community Facilities Loan and Grant Program for the construction, furnishing and equipping of a full-sized Animal Shelter. Commissioner Anderson suggested inviting some of the Non-Profit groups for the animal shelter and animal control personnel to be part of the homelessness workshop.
