





Members Absent: Lisa Shirey, Tim Isbel, Terry Frank, Michael Foster and Christine Michaels

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Katy Watt and seconded by Amanda Bridges to approve the July 2023 minutes. Motion passed.

Financial Report: A motion was made by Rick Meredith and seconded by Brent Galloway to approve the Final FY 2023 Financial Report and the FY 2024 Quarterly Financial Reports. Motion passed. Reports attached.

Old Business/New Business

- A motion was made by Katy Watt and seconded by Beth Hickman to transfer \$100,000 from the Tourism Fund Balance to operating expense for the TDTD Tourism Enhancement Grant. Motion passed.
- Director Wells presented the ACTC Enhancement Project Request from the City of Norris. The request was tabled until the next meeting so that Director Wells could get clarification on the projects from the City of Norris.
- A motion was made by Katy Watt and seconded by Katherine Birkbeck to approve the FY 2024 Advertising Budget and ARPA Spending Plan. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Amanda Bridges and seconded by Brent Galloway to approve the 2024 meeting schedule which is January 9th, April 2nd, July 23rd and October 1st. Motion passed.

Executive's Report, given by Stephanie Wells

- The Quarterly Website Visitation and Social Media Report was presented with the disclaimer that the AdventureAnderson.com website has been switched over to Google 4 Analytics. The new platform started tracking website performance on February 18, 2023 with different metrics than the previous platform. Therefore, you can not compare year-over-year data. Regardless, the website has 107,006 users from February 18, 2023 to September 30, 2023. The new platform does report organic social acquisition which was 28,817 users for the same time period. Another interesting data point to report is that 78% of the website users are accessing the site from a mobile device. The Facebook and Instagram Report is for January 1, 2023 to September 30, 2023 and reflects that 1.04 million users were reached through Facebook and 113,666 through Instagram. See the complete attached report for more information.
- Wells reported that during the next quarter, the Tourism Council will be working on the Day-Trip Campaign with the cities, gathering video and photography content for the spring campaign, writing content for the new spokesperson campaign, legislation to allow ATVs on Highway 61 in Oliver Springs, the Norris Freeway Scenic Byway grant and signage and developing the 2024 content calendar.
- A Placer report comparing calendar year 2019 to calendar year 2022 was reviewed and showed a 9% increase in visitation to Anderson County. Report Attached.
- Wells presented the 2022 TDTD Tourism Economic Impact Report for Anderson County with the board, pointing out that direct visitor spending was \$180.8 million which is a 13% increase over 2021 and that every household in Anderson County saved \$578 in taxes in 2022 because of tourism. Anderson County is #16 out of 95 counties in economic impact.
- Wells reported that the AdventureAnderson.com website is undergoing updates in addition to revamping the event page and adding a Group Sales page.

- The board discussed the TDTD Music Pathway Marker reveal for Dean Dillion. Wells was appreciative of everyone that helped to make that event a success and that attended. She coordinated the event with the state based on the availability of Mr. Dillion. The event was regarded as a success especially considering the limited planning time. The marker information has been added to the adventureanderson.com website. w
- Wells reported that a faith based film production company has been filming in the Briceville/New River area and has plans to film more movies in that area.
- The Norris Lake Cleanup was conducted on September 16th and launched from Anderson County Park and Shanghai Marina. Collectively, there were 75 volunteers that picked up 11,260 pounds of trash including large barrels, houseboat floats, Styrofoam, a plastic storage unit, a semi truck tire and a microwave.






