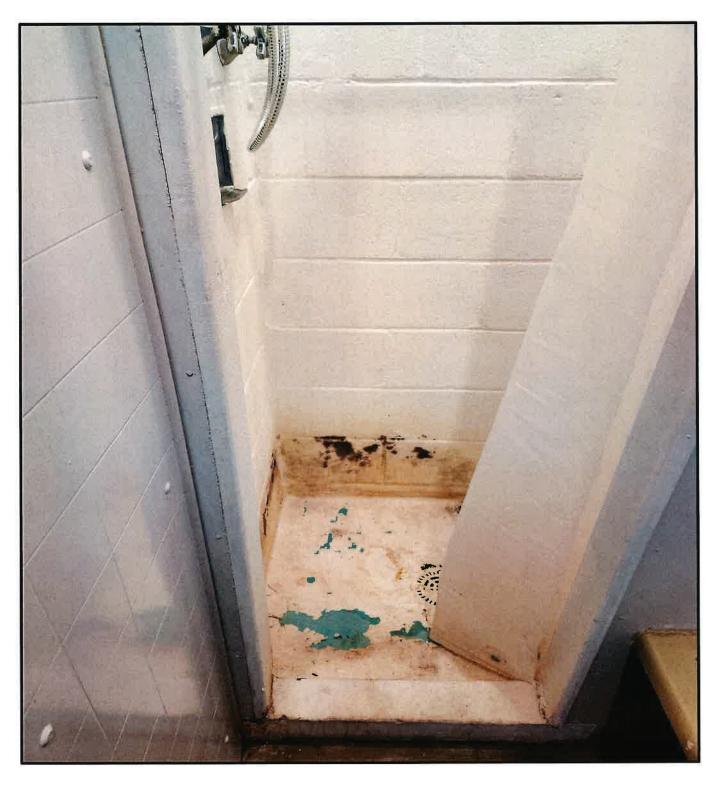

Director Holbrook,

Would you place on the other business for discussion a request to discuss property for the Animal Shelter?

In 2019, the City of Clinton agreed to a low-cost lease for approximately 5 acres of City of Clinton owed land for use as the location of an animal shelter. (20 years, 20 year renewal=\$40.00)

Anderson County succeeded in obtaining approval for a loan through the USDA Community Facilities program, however, we have now learned we must own the land. We have put considerable time and money into the property in order to get an archaeological survey, and more in order to meet USDA requirements. The land, location, conditions, etc. had to be part of the application.

I would like to request funds to purchase the land from the City of Clinton up to \$70,000. (I note up to \$70,000 based on a recent sale of similar property owned by the City of Clinton based on \$15,000 an acre for industrial property, and this property is also industrial.)

I know we have sufficient funds that are restricted for capital outlay that could be used for this purchase; or funds that are committed for future land purchase-industrial (and this land is in an industrial park.)

I do not know if the City of Clinton would agree to sell, or would accept this offer, but I would like to request the funds be set allocated in the amount up to \$70,000 in order to allow me to work with the City for the request and/or negotiation.

If you are able to add to the agenda, I would be very grateful!
