Please find attached the 2024 TNRMT invoice. A complete copy of the renewal is filed in HR.

The invoice has increased by \$153,971 from the 2023 renewal. Both property (\$84,383) and worker's compensation (\$69,588) have gone up an estimated 12.4%.

After speaking with the carrier today, there are several factors contributing to this year's increase.

1. Property \$863,104

Estimated increase from prior year is 11%.

- a. Industry increases
  - i. Replacement cost
  - ii. Weather changes creating modifications in premiums, or premiums and deductibles.
    - 1. EX: Windstorm/hail damage is seeing a 2% increase in deductible, an increase by \$100,000, or both.

WHEREAS, the public safety and healthcare sector continues to experience staffing struggles locally, regionally, statewide, and nationally; and

WHEREAS, Anderson County will partner with numerous area governments and agencies to develop, equip, and staff a Training Facility in Anderson County managed by Anderson County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to provide training in Emergency Medical Response, Emergency Medical Technician, Advanced EMT and other public safety courses;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, meeting in regular session on Monday, April 15, 2024, that we, the Anderson County Board of Commissioners, commit to applying for the FY 2024-2025 ARC POWER Grant to develop and equip an approximately 6,000-square-foot training facility, and staffing costs over a 3-year period.

Robby,

Under Mayor's section, will you also add to the discussion lighting on SR 170/Edgemoor Road? As you may recall, I presented a budget amendment request for the initial funding request in the amount of \$239,640 for our engineering portion. The full construction cost is an additional \$2,396,370. That was voted down, and I was requested to work further to try and obtain state funding.

I have located no additional funding for the county for this project. I did successfully work with partners at the state and local level, including the City of Oak Ridge, to align the construction timeline in a way that benefits both the city and county.

I would like the ability to release this contract back to TDOT and the authority to reach out to TDOT to restart lighting discussions for reduced areas of lighting coverage, for example, safety areas at signalized intersections, or a crosswalk.
